- All arrangements for interment will be under the direction of the Rector of St. Mark's Church.
- Only human cremains shall be interred, one individual per niche.
- The inscription on the niche will consist only of the name and year of birth and death of the deceased.
- The purchaser of a Certificate acquires no property rights in the Columbarium or its niches and agrees that said areas are at all times under the sole jurisdiction and control of St. Mark's Church.
- The Purchaser may assign the Certificate to another person only with the approval of St. Mark's Vestry.
- Cremains may be permanently removed from the Columbarium upon written request by the next of kin, heir or legal representative of the person whose ashes are interred. In the event of such removal all rights to the niche revert to St. Mark's Church and there will be no refund.
- If the purchased niche is not used within five years of the death of the intended recipient, all rights to the niche shall revert to St. Mark's Church and there will be no refund.
- If after purchase of the Certificate, the use of the niche is no longer needed and ashes have not yet be interred the Certificate may be returned to St. Mark's Church and the Purchaser will receive a refund of the direct cost portion of the fee, but not of the tax-deductible donation.
- The purchase fee will be in two parts: the first to cover the expense of the niche engraving the inscription and other direct costs, the second to provide for long term maintenance of the Columbarium. This second part will be a Tax-deductible contribution to St. Mark's.
